Last year we were lucky, and experienced no threats, however this year we may not be as lucky. Our hurricane haul out list works in three steps:

- First communication – we alert you through email if there is an approaching hurricane.
- Second email will come as the hurricane approaches our region of the East Coast.
- Third and final communication – is an email followed up with a call that we have started the haul out process as a hurricane is forecasted for our area. When you receive this communication you need to make the decision to haul your boat or not.

During hurricane Sandy in 2012 we were able to haul out everyone on our list but we came very close in running out of time and equipment before the storm hit. In the event of a hurricane approaching you need to let us know if you want your boat hauled as soon as possible, as space fills up quickly and boat stands run low.
